About Metal Furniture.

Specializing in high performance furnishings engineered to withstand the elements, quality materials are at the foundation of every Walters product. Our metal frames are built using stainless steel or aluminum, which are powder coated for top of the line durability.

While powder coat finishes are extremely durable, it is possible to chip or scratch them. A regular, simple cleaning program will maximize the longevity of the powder coat finish.

Cleaning.

- Loose debris deposits can be removed with a wet sponge or rag.
- Using a soft brush and a mild household detergent solution, gently scrub any soiled areas. Finish by rinsing with fresh water.
- Generally, cleaning every six months is recommended. In areas that are near the ocean or exposed to pollutants, cleaning every few months is preferable.

Guidelines.

- Do not use an abrasive cleaner, sponge, or steel brush.
- Do not use any solutions including bleach.
- If prepping furniture for winter storage or other long term storage, it's best to clean furniture prior to doing so. Contact Walters or your Dealer for information about custom-fit protective covers.

General Recommendations.

- We strongly suggest using outdoor covers to best protect furniture from outdoor conditions.
- Avoid allowing water to stay on the surface of furniture and fabric covers.
- Although Outdoor Dry Fast cushions may be used, we recommend cushions to be removed - when possible - when covering the frames to prevent mold and mildew build-up.
- It's recommended to tilt even Outdoor Dry Fast seat cushions upright during periods of rain to improve drying times.



Stainless Steel.

- Stainless steel is not recommended in coastal environments. Ocean air and salt water can damage the stainless-steel finish.
- If a stain or rust spot appears clean promptly. Rust can permanently etch the steel surface if untreated. Apply a non-abrasive stainless-steel cleaner/polish. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Rub with the grain not in a circular motion. Rinse thoroughly with water and dry.
- If stain still remains use a no scratch scrub sponge or hand pad to polish the stainless steel.
- Do not use bleach, cleaners with bleach, hydrochloric acid, abrasive pads or cleaners.

Items Placed In Water (special provisions required)

Not all furniture is pool-safe and we strongly do not suggest items be submerged in water for extended periods of times. Special manufacturing provisions must be taken and Walters must be alerted prior to ensure safety for in-water use.

For items that have been made specifically for pool use, it's important to remove the furniture and wash a minimum of every 2 weeks with warm soap and water. Chemicals such as chlorine and even salt water can degrade metal components over time.



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
